

We have reported on both our Scope 1 & 2 for our last financial year 2023 and or base year 2022. A copy of this report is available on our website at www.nicholloils.com. We have recently completed our ESOS audit to help us identify some areas where we can get savings on energy which will lead to a reduction in emissions. We envisage that we will implement any measures that will reduce our emissions over the next 10 years.

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 1450 tCO₂e by 2029. This is a reduction of 20%
